

Establishing a Culture of Safety Is Not One-Size-Fits-All, New Blueprint Can Help

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A new guide from the National Patient Safety Foundation (NPSF) aims to help leadership establish and assess existing efforts to improve safety culture. *Leading a Culture of Safety: A Blueprint for Success* is an evidence-based resource developed by the NPSF and American College of Healthcare Executives. The guide is divided into two levels: a foundational level, which provides basic tactics and strategies to implement safety programs; and a sustaining level with strategies for spreading and embedding a culture of safety within an organization. Since each organization is different, the guide allows leaders to select elements from each level and work on tactics that are best suited for them individually. "Whether an organization is just beginning the journey to a culture of safety or is working to sustain its safe culture," NPSF said, the guide may be useful "to direct efforts and evaluate an organization's success along the journey to zero harm."
